Discussion Points:

Approval of Previous Minutes

The minutes of the previous CEC meeting were presented for review and approved by the committee.

Industry Events & Institutional Representation

- The committee discussed participation and institutional representation in industry events, emphasizing the importance of inclusive coordination, stronger stakeholder engagement, and timely communication regarding national-level initiatives.
- Members highlighted the need to strengthen institutional collaboration mechanisms to ensure consistent representation of P@SHA and relevant committees at industry events and engagements. Skills Development & Strategic Partnerships
