

Secretariat Updates

License Renewal

- SG shared that P@SHA's DGTO license has been renewed. She shared about the effort that went into it from the Secretariat side over the past few months.
- More than 15 letters were sent and more than 15 visits have been done in renewing the DGTO license

Membership Renewal

- The renewal process is currently in the execution process. An official email has been already shared with all members. Follow-ups are being made with in-active companies.
- Renewal highlights and yearly updates for members are planned to be launched soon.
- The renewal form has been carefully designed to identify and address concerns regarding IT revenue and related details. Barkan raised the concern about membership criteria, but Salman proposed to finalize it in the membership committee first.
