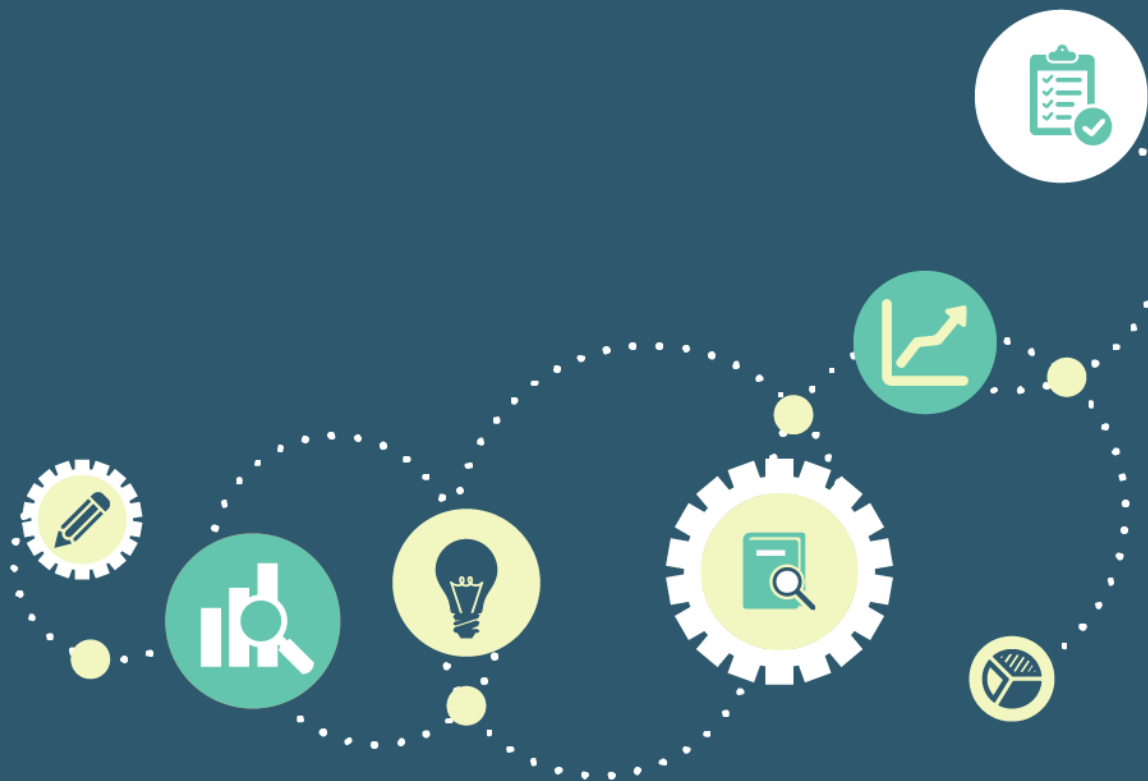

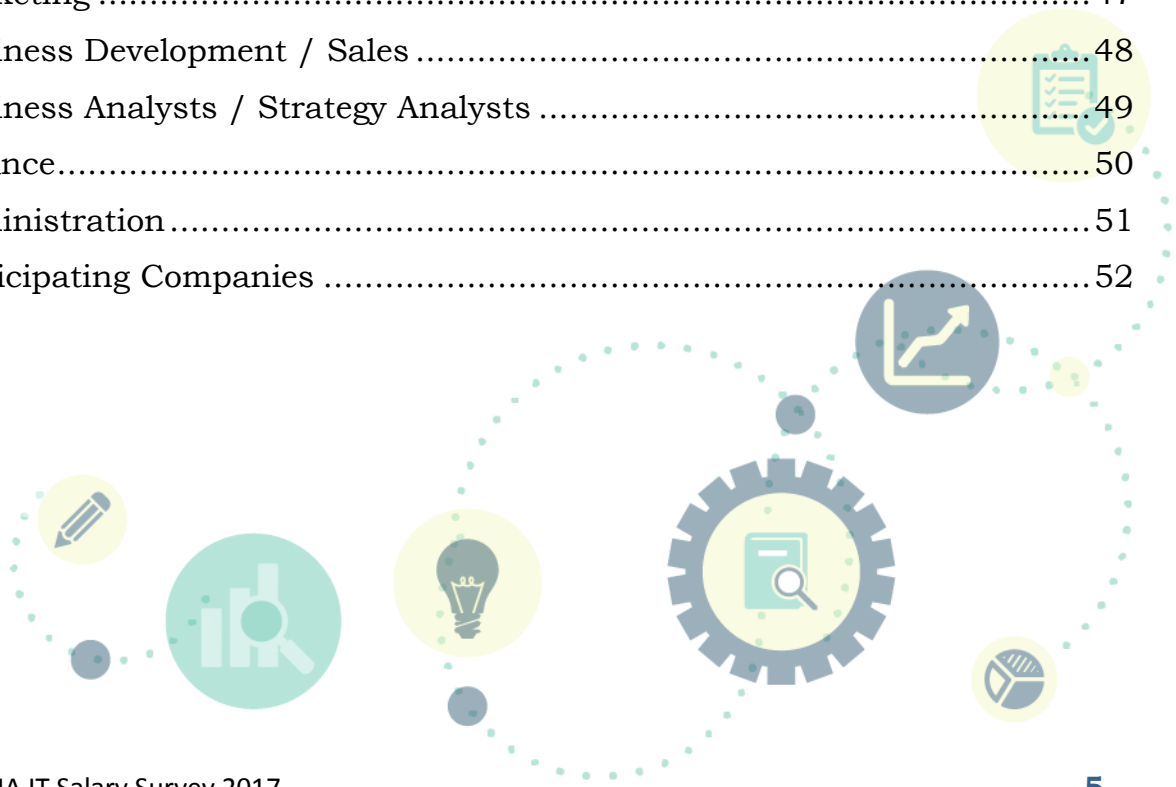

With over 450+ member companies nationwide P@SHA has been the voice of the industry, advocating policy initiatives and working towards creating a high growth sustainable business environment in the country.

About P@SHA IT Salary Survey

The P@SHA IT Salary Survey is an annual study conducted by P@SHA highlighting the salaries, benefits, promotions and increments for employees working in the IT industry of Pakistan. The 2017 edition features findings from 130 companies all over Pakistan, and has compiled data of 31,801 employees working in 28 job roles and 98 unique job levels in both IT and non-IT capacities. All roles are further broken down into experience levels. The survey provides changes in salaries for each job function and level (entry, mid and senior level) as well as the increments, bonuses and benefits that are offered to the employees.

We hope that this comprehensive study will enable companies to benchmark the salaries and growth timelines for their employee base efficiently.

Executive Summary

The 2017 edition of P@SHA IT Salary Survey identifies average salary nationally and city wise along with average increments, promotions and benefits for 28 job roles within the IT Industry. Each role has been subdivided into experience levels to present findings for 98 distinct job levels, and this year the survey features data from a total of 31,801 employees working in 130 participating companies. 44% companies and 13,984 (44%) employees are from Karachi, 26% companies and 13,149 (41%) employees are from Lahore and 27% companies and 4,397 (14%) employees were from Islamabad. 4 companies from Peshawar and Faisalabad also participated in the survey this year.

There are three distinctions of job levels covered throughout the survey, an entry level function denotes 0-3 years of experience, middle level is supposed to have 4-6 years of experience and a senior function depicts 6+ years of experience (unless otherwise stated). Each function is presented on a unique page to maintain clarity and comprehension.

The survey reveals there has been an overall increment of 16.37% in salaries across all job functions when compared to 2016. The highest paid job function is the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) who on average earns PKR 520,650 (which is an increase of 7.46% over 2016). The highest increase in salary this year has been witnessed in Entry Level Game Designer role with a growth of 38.52%. On the other hand, the position of a Senior BPO Professional witnessed the smallest increase of 3.31% in salary.

A summary of findings for average monthly salary for each job function appears next, detailed findings appear on the subsequent pages.

Primary Business Areas

63% of the respondent companies have indicated Application Development as their primary business area, while 38% shared IT Consulting, 17% focus on BPO, 9% on Business Transformation, 4% work in hardware, 17% in CRM solutions, 27% deal in e-commerce, 14% in ERP solutions, 7% in Internet Services, 8% in Mobile commerce, 34% Mobile Applications, 17% in SEO & SMM, 12% work as Strategy Consultants, 22% as System Integrators, 9% work in Telecom solutions, 7% Retail Solutions, 18% work as resellers, 13% have Game Development as their primary business area and 29% indicated other areas.

Company Sizes

If we look at the size of the companies who participated this year we have 41 (32%) small companies (who have less than 25 employees), 44 (34%) Medium sized companies (who have between 25 and 100 employees) and 45 (34%) large companies having over 100 employees.

Number of Companies

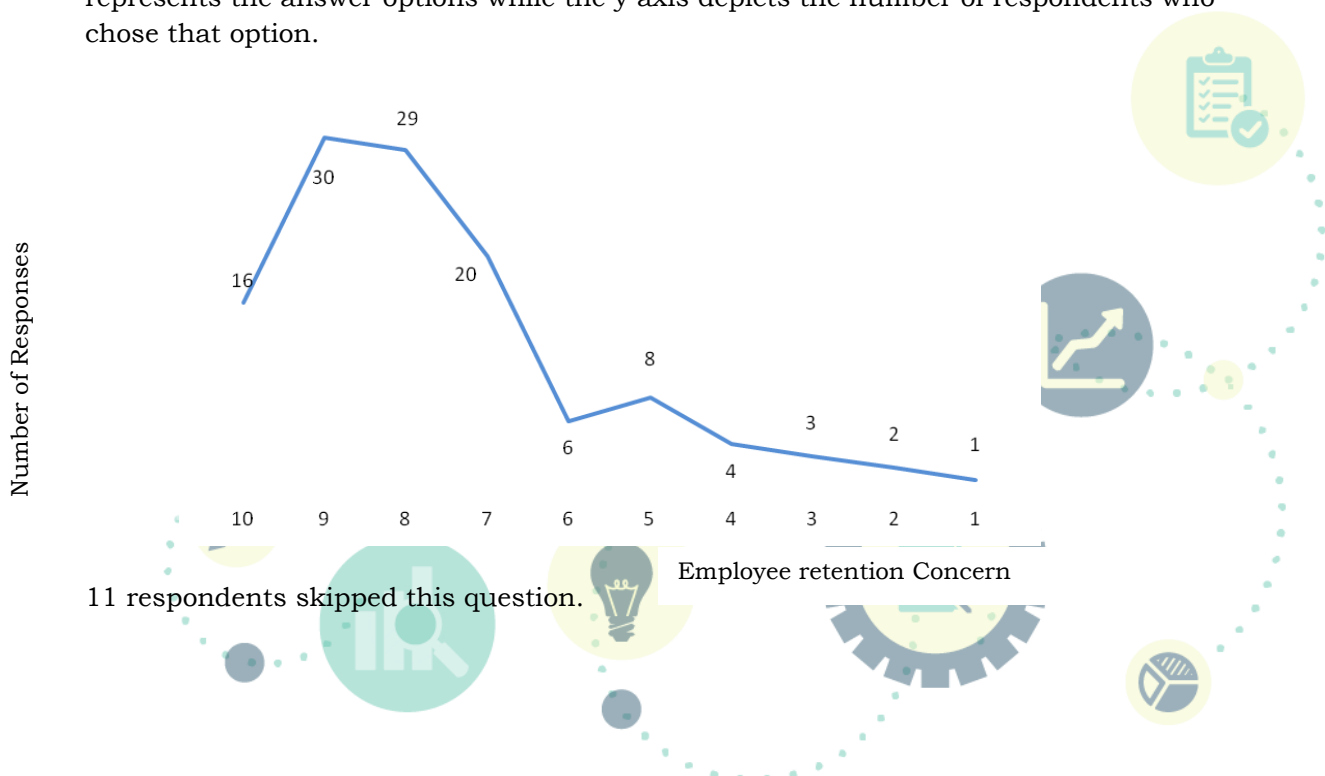
130 companies nationwide participated in the survey, of which 57 (44%) were from Karachi, 34 (26%) were from Lahore, 35 (27%) were from Islamabad while 4 companies were from Peshawar and Faisalabad.

Number of Employees

The total number of employees represented by the 130 participating companies is 31,801. Of these 13,984 (44%) were from Karachi, 13,149 (41%) were from Lahore and 4,397 (14%) were from Islamabad.

Employee retention as a Concern for Companies

We asked the respondents that on a scale of 1 to 10 how important would they describe employee retention as a concern for their organisation, 1 being least important and 10 being the most. 58% chose options 8,9 & 10 indicating a very strong concern existing in the industry for retaining employees. The graph shows all the responses received, the x axis represents the answer options while the y axis depicts the number of respondents who chose that option.



Employee Turnover

We asked our respondents how many of their employees left during the year, 30% said less than 5% of their employees left in 2016-2017, 20% indicated 5-10% employee turnover, 18% said between 10-20%, 20% shared 20-30% while 12% said more than 30%.

Practice of Long Service Awards

The survey reveals that 55% of the companies do recognize employees who have been a part of the company for longer durations through long service awards however 45% stated that they do not practice long service awards.

Efforts to maintain Gender balance

We asked our respondents if they take special measures to ensure gender balance in their workforce, the responses were more inclined towards “YES”. 64% said that they do take measures to maintain a balance between number of male and female employees while 34% indicated that they do not take such measures.

3 of the 130 respondents refrained from answering the question.

Average Working Hours Per Week

52% of the companies indicated that they work for 40 hours per week which can be termed as 8 hours per day and 5 days a week. The second popular answer was 45 hours per week meaning 9 hours per day for a 5 day week or 8 hours per day during weekdays and a 5 hour Saturday. 10% of the companies disclosed that they work for 50 hours every week and another 7% said that they worked for 54 hours per week.

Frequency of Bonuses

60% of the companies said that they annually give bonuses, 22% said that they give bonuses twice a year while 14% said they follow a quarterly mechanism.

Number of Sick Leaves Allowed in A Year

We asked our respondents how many sick leaves employees are allowed in a calendar year. 55% of the respondent companies provide 6-10 days of sick leaves while 18% say 0-5 days, 13% 11-15 days, 8% over 21 days and 6% between 16 to 20 days.

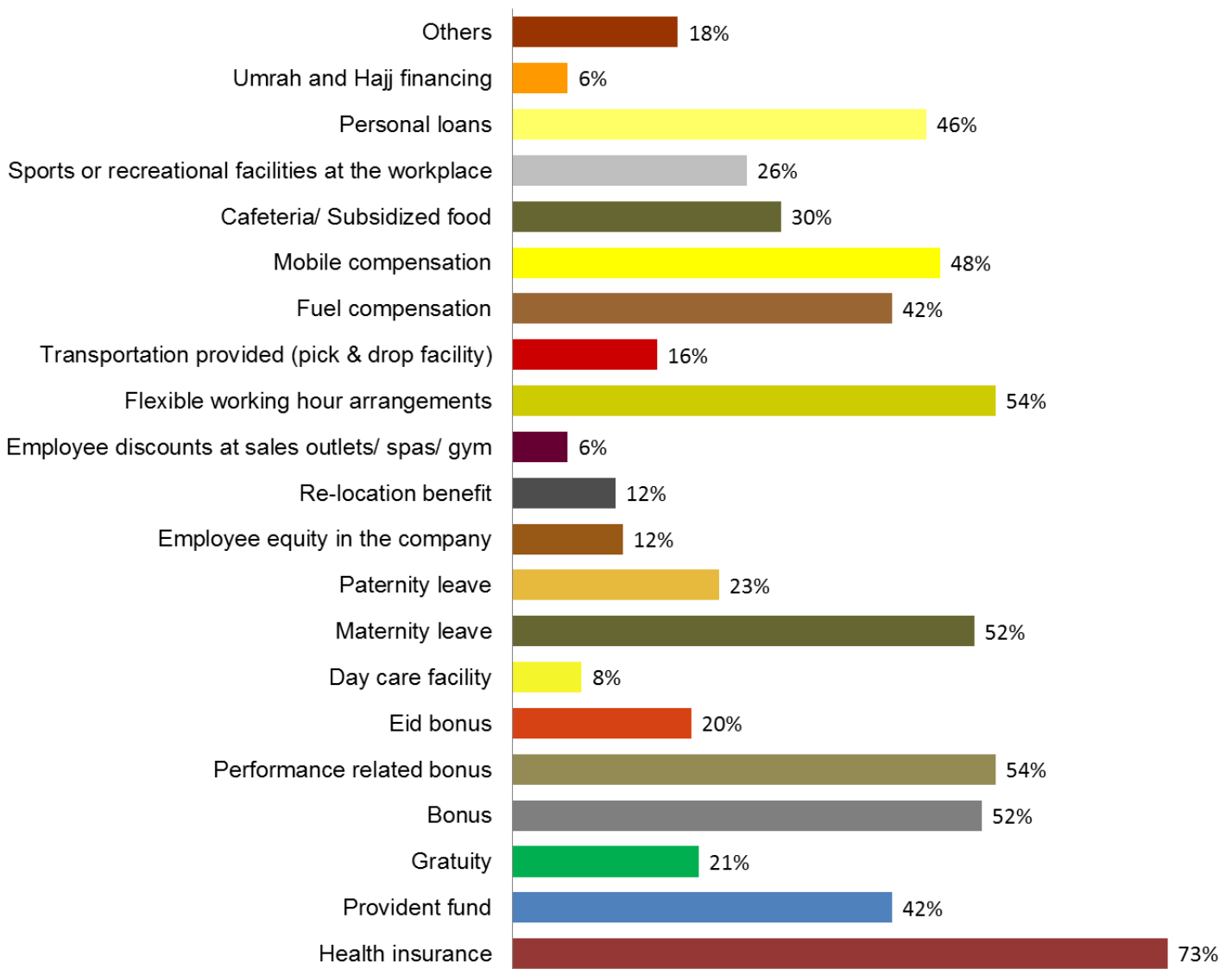
Number of Casual Leaves allowed in a Year

We also asked our respondents the number of casual leaves they allow their employees in a calendar year. 32% of the respondent companies provide 6-10 days of casual leaves while 35% say 11-15 days, 15% 0-5 days, 6% over 21 days and another 12% between 16 to 20 days.



General Benefits

We asked our respondents what general benefits they offer to all their employees and 73% companies say they provide health insurance, 42% say they have provident fund, 52% say they give bonuses while another 54% say they give performance bonuses. 52% of the companies have provisions for maternity leave while only 23% say they give paternity leaves. 54% companies within our sample have flexible working hour arrangements, 42% provide fuel compensation and 48% employers cover mobile expenses. 46% companies indicated that their employees have access to personal loans from the company while only 6% said that they have Hajj & Umrah financing options for their employees. The histogram below shows the number of companies with the general benefits they offer.



Software Architect

The survey included findings from 695 architects nationwide with 319 (46%) of them working in entry levels, 256 (37%) in middle level and 120 (17%) work at senior levels. It reveals average national basic monthly salaries of Rs. 92,500 for entry level software architects, Rs. 116,720 for middle level software architects and Rs. 206,960 for senior level software architects.

Entry Level

The 2017 results reveal 12.44% increase over 2016 with average national salary of Rs. 92,500. Karachi professionals earn Rs. 97,748 per month while average salaries for Lahore professionals remained Rs.89,763 and Islamabad professionals earn Rs 94,976 per month.

22% of the entry level professionals are entitled to no benefits, while 52% are provided with mobile phones, 13% with mobile phones + fuel and 13% are given other benefits

47% of the entry level professionals were promoted within the last year, 44% within last 6 months and 9% are not promoted since hired.

44% of the entry level employees were given increments between 25% to 30% of their existing salaries this year, 14% were given increments between 30% & 35%, 15% were subject to increments between 20% and 25%, 19% were given increments between 10% and 15% and 8% between 35% & 40%.

Middle Level

There has been a 10.44% increase in 2017 over last year with average national salary of 116,720. Karachi professionals earn Rs. 112,204 per month while average salaries for Lahore professionals remained Rs. 118,916 and Islamabad professionals earn Rs 120,574 per month.

38% of the middle level professionals are entitled to mobile phones and fuel, 24% are provided car and mobile phone as benefits, while 17% are provided with car + mobile phones + fuel and 21% are given other benefits

40% of the middle level professionals were promoted within the last year, 26% within last 6 months, 15% within last two year and 19% more than 2 years ago.

18% of the middle level employees were given increments between 25% to 30% of their existing salaries this year, 22% were given increments between 30% & 35%, 17% were subject to increments between 20% and 25%, 32% were given increments between 10% and 15% and 11% between 35% & 40%.

Senior Level

The 2017 results reveal 12.28% increase over 2016 with average national salary of 206,960. Karachi professionals earn Rs. 210,561 per month while average salaries for Lahore professionals remained 196,675 and Islamabad professionals earn Rs 197,107 per month.

32% of the senior level professionals are entitled to a car, while 37% are provided with fuel + mobile phones, 16% with car + mobile phone and 15% are given other benefits

24% of the senior level professionals were promoted within the last year, 13% within last 6 months, 32% within last two years and 31% more than 2 years ago.

47% of the senior level employees were given increments between 15% to 20% of their existing salaries this year, 14% were given increments between 20% & 25%, 15% were subject to increments between 25% and 30%, 13% were given increments between 30% and 35% and 11% between 35% & 40%

BPO Customer Service Professional

The survey included findings from 2094 BPO customer service professionals nationwide with 1103 (53%) of them working in entry levels, 743 (36%) in middle level and 248 (12%) working in senior levels. It reveals average national basic monthly salaries of Rs. 45,840 for entry level BPO professionals, Rs. 76,844 for middle level professionals and Rs. 94,251 for senior level BPO professionals.

Entry Level

The 2017 results reveal 29.34% increase over 2016 with average national salary of Rs. 45,840. Karachi professionals earn Rs. 47,224 per month while average salaries for Lahore professionals remained Rs. 44,532 and Islamabad professionals earn Rs 43,951 per month.

46% of the entry level professionals are entitled to mobile phones, while 21% are provided with fuel + mobile phones, 16% with only fuel and 17% are given other benefits

54% of the entry level professionals were promoted within the last year, 38% within last 6 months and 8% are not promoted since hired.

29% of the entry level employees were given increments between 15% to 20% of their existing salaries this year, 19% were given increments between 20% & 25%, 16% were subject to increments between 25% and 30%, 8% were given increments between 30% and 35% and 8% between 35% & 40%.

Middle Level

There has been a 18.33% increase in 2017 over last year with average national salary of 76,844. Karachi professionals earn Rs. 80,594 per month while average salaries for Lahore professionals remained Rs. 72,835 and Islamabad professionals earn Rs 81,139 per month.

34% of the middle level professionals are entitled to mobile phones and fuel, 29% are provided car and mobile phone as benefits, while 14% are provided with car + mobile phones + fuel and 23% are given other benefits

23% of the middle level professionals were promoted within the last year, 14% within last 6 months, 47% within last two year and 16% more than 2 years ago.

31% of the middle level employees were given increments between 15% to 20% of their existing salaries this year, 9% were given increments between 20% & 25%, 18% were subject to increments between 25% and 30%, 29% were given increments between 30% and 35% and 13% between 35% & 40%.

Senior Level

The 2017 results reveal 3.31% increase over 2016 with average national salary of 94,251. Karachi professionals earn Rs. 94,120 per month while average salaries for Lahore professionals remained 96,404 and Islamabad professionals earn Rs 92,717 per month.

29% of the senior level professionals are entitled to a car, while 31% are provided with fuel + mobile phones, 16% with car + mobile phone and 24% are given other benefits

22% of the senior level professionals were promoted within the last year, 12% within last 6 months, 34% within last two years and 32% more than 2 years ago.

42% of the senior level employees were given increments between 15% to 20% of their existing salaries this year, 17% were given increments between 20% & 25%, 15% were subject to increments between 25% and 30%, 16% were given increments between 30% and 35% and 10% between 35% & 40%.

Programmer Android

The survey included findings from 228 Android Programmers nationwide with 122 (54%) of them working in entry levels and 106 (46%) in middle level. It reveals average national basic monthly salaries of Rs. 60,190 for entry level professionals and Rs. 155,120 for middle level professionals.

Entry Level

The 2017 results reveal 16.99% increase over 2016 with average national salary of Rs. 60,190. Karachi professionals earn Rs. 57,237 per month while average salaries for Lahore professionals remained Rs. 64,444 and Islamabad professionals earn Rs 60,254 per month.

18% of the entry level professionals are entitled to mobile phones, while 9% are provided with fuel + mobile phones, 3% with car + fuel, 27% with only fuel and 43% are given other benefits

31% of the entry level professionals were promoted within the last year, 26% within last 6 months and 43% are not promoted since hired.

32% of the entry level employees were given increments between 10% to 15% of their existing salaries this year, 26% were given increments between 15% & 20%, 26% were subject to increments between 20% & 25%, 9% were given increments between 30% & 35% and 7% between 35% & 40%

Middle Level

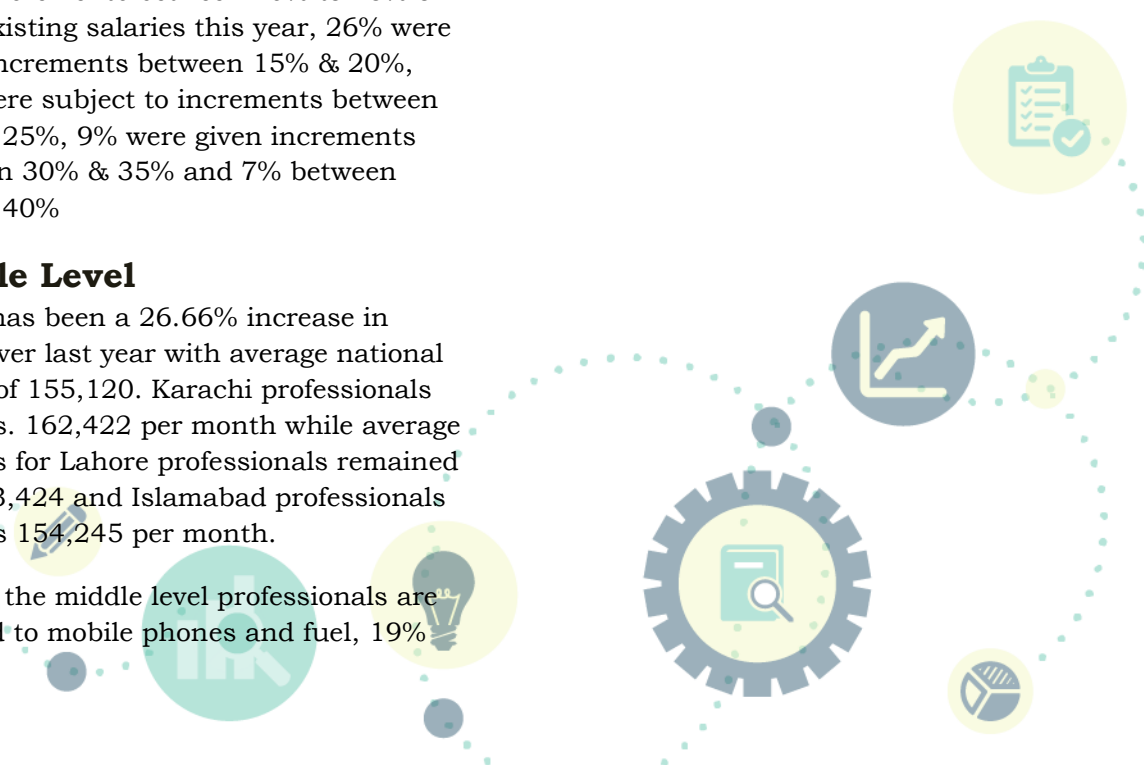
There has been a 26.66% increase in 2017 over last year with average national salary of 155,120. Karachi professionals earn Rs. 162,422 per month while average salaries for Lahore professionals remained Rs. 153,424 and Islamabad professionals earn Rs 154,245 per month.

40% of the middle level professionals are entitled to mobile phones and fuel, 19%

are provided a car and mobile phone as benefits, while 6% are provided with car + mobile phone + fuel and 35% are given other benefits

21% of the middle level professionals were promoted within the last year, 4% within last 6 months, 51% within last two year and 24% more than 2 years ago.

25% of the middle level employees were given increments between 10% to 15% of their existing salaries this year, 19% were given increments between 15% & 20%, 21% were subject to increments between 20% and 25%, 23% were given increments between 25% & 30% and 12% between 30% & 35%.



Programmer iOS

27% of the entry level employees were given increments between 10% to 15% of their existing salaries this year, 19% were given increments between 15% & 20%, 26% were subject to increments between 20% & 25%, 15% were given increments between 30% & 35% and 13% between 35% & 40%.

Middle Level

There has been a 26.63% increase in 2017 over last year with average national salary of 62,368. Karachi professionals earn Rs. 64,284 per month while average salaries for Lahore professionals remained Rs. 58,239 and Islamabad professionals earn Rs 65,717 per month.

27% of the middle level professionals are entitled to mobile phones and fuel, 16% are provided a car and phone as benefits, while 18% are provided with car + phone + fuel and 39% are given other benefits

22% of the middle level professionals were promoted within the last year, 12% within last 6 months, 34% within last two year and 32% more than 2 years ago.

24% of the middle level employees were given increments between 10% to 15% of their existing salaries this year, 28% were given increments between 15% & 20%, 21% were subject to increments between 20% and 25%, 13% were given increments between 25% & 30% and 14% between 30% & 35%.

Senior Level

The 2017 results reveal 15.76% increase over 2016 with average national salary of 90,457. Karachi professionals earn Rs. 89,707 per month while average salaries for Lahore professionals remained Rs. 92,336 and Islamabad professionals earn Rs 91,260 per month.

26% of the senior level professionals are entitled to a car, while 28% are provided with fuel + mobile phones, 17% with car + mobile phone and 29% are given other benefits

22% of the senior level professionals were promoted within the last year, 10% within last 6 months, 35% within last two years and 33% more than 2 years ago.

29% of the senior level employees were given increments between 10% to 15% of their existing salaries this year, 24% were given increments between 15% & 20%, 21% were subject to increments between 20% and 25%, 14% were given increments between 25% and 30% and 12% between 35% & 40%.
